Reception Rooms

Ballroom:



Dating back to the early part of the nineteenth century the oak-panelled Ballroom still boasts its original oak sprung dance floor. Impressive features include a raised stage area, crystal chandeliers, open fireplace and French windows leading out onto the terrace and gardens. Three arched panelled doors open onto the adjoining Pools Theatre. The entrance to the Ballroom is via the Club Bar.

Club Bar:



Originally the gun room, a cocktail bar was added and eventually it adopted the name the Club Bar. Backed by the stunning fireplace and leather chairs, the Club Bar is the perfect room for pre-dinner drinks.

Pools Theatre:



Originally built as a swimming pool, the Pools Theatre has now been converted into an unusual split-level auditorium and banqueting suite which interconnects with the Ballroom. This wonderful one of a kind room offers a fantastic setting for those larger celebrations.

Civil Ceremonies

Hitchcock Room:



A Georgian-style room with an ornamental fireplace, white columns and French windows leading into the gardens, thus providing superb views for your momentous occasion.

History

Did you know:

- Heatherden Hall has a fascinating history and catalogue of notable owners including the famous Indian cricketer K.S. Rhanjitsinhji and Canadian financier Lt. Col. Grant Morden.
- In the early 1900s the original house was transformed into a Victorian showpiece, with a huge ballroom and a Turkish bath.
- In the 1920s it became a retreat for politicians and diplomats and, in November 1921, provided the venue for the negotiation and signing of the Irish Free State Treaty.
- In 1934 the house was bought at auction by the prominent builder Charles Boot. He was later to meet J. Arthur Rank and would become his partner in the studio project.
- The first production to take place at Pinewood was "London Melody" in 1936, and by it's 60th anniversary Pinewood had produced no less than 600 films, both for the big screen and television.
- Classic films created at Pinewood include "Chitty Chitty Bang Bang"; "Oliver Twist" and "Great Expectations", directed by David Lean; Lord Olivier and Marilyn Monroe's "The Prince & The Showgirl" (her only film ever made outside of Hollywood); "The Great Gatsby"; "Bugsy Malone"; The "Doctor" films: the "Carry On" films and most of the "James Bond" adventures.
- More recently Pinewood Studios has accommodated some of the most spectacular moments, memorable stars and ambitious sets on screen. Jason Bourne, Batman, Lara Croft and Superman have all walked the corridors, while the stages and backlots have become Greek fishing villages, Venetian palazzos, ice palaces, Cambodian tombs, space ships and Paris opera houses.

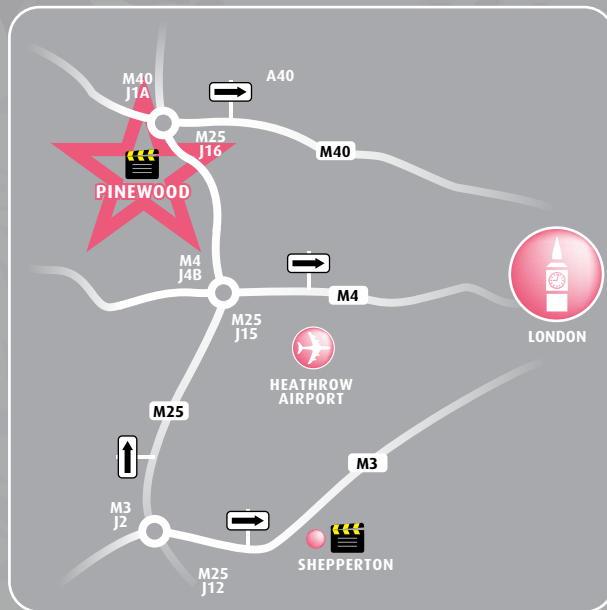
